MARK “MICK” MIKLOS, CP-FS – PROGRAM DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL RESTAURANT ASSOCIATION RECEIVES THE ASSOCIATION OF FOOD & DRUG OFFICIALS (AFDO) INDUSTRY ASSOCIATE MEMBER AWARD



Burlington, Vermont – Mark “Mick” Miklos, CP-FS, National Restaurant Association was awarded the AFDO Industry Associate Member Award at the 122nd AFDO Annual Educational Conference on June 12, 2018.

Qualification for this award is based upon long-term active membership in the Association, active involvement in committee work, development of model codes and demonstrated promotion of the objectives of the Association. This award is presented each year at the Annual Educational Conference.
