The Working Group used the reviewers' comments and worked on numerous action items in March 2018. The Committee would like to acknowledge all the wonderful feedback received from reviewers.

The Food Emergency Regulator Pocket Guide update was completed and sent to AFDO for printing in May 2018. The Pocket Guide remains in its current size but now has plain text tabs and colored charts/graphics. Printed copies of the Pocket Guide will be revealed and shared during the Food Protection and Defense Committee meeting on June 10, 2018. The Committee would like to note our appreciation to the entire Food Emergency Pocket Guide Working Group for completing this project, and highlight Jennifer Bonsky (MI)'s contribution, in addition to being a lead author, she spent many additional hours harmonizing edits and formatting the Pocket Guide this spring in order to finalize it in time for the AFDO Annual Education Conference.
