<u>Discussion:</u> In the last year, "CDC Food Safety Centers of Excellence" (CoE) expanded to include New York State as a Center, established a northeast region and developed a point of contact map. Each region is served by a CoE state to establish clear points of contact to guide jurisdictions to available resources. CoE also maintains a well-developed website (http://www.coefoodsafetytools.org/) sharing the numerous resources and training opportunities available.



Recommendation: Continue Charge with outreach to CoE Directors, introducing AFDO and exploring opportunities to collaborate such as offering subject matter expertise, review and comment on resources during development, etc.

The AFDO Foodborne Illness and Emergency Response Committee served as a review group. The

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committee members provided recommendations and comments which were included in a draft final report that has gone out to the workgroup for review. A final report is expected to be submitted to the PFP Governing Council late summer or early fall.
