Overall, State and Federal regulatory field inspection audit performance trends are unknown.



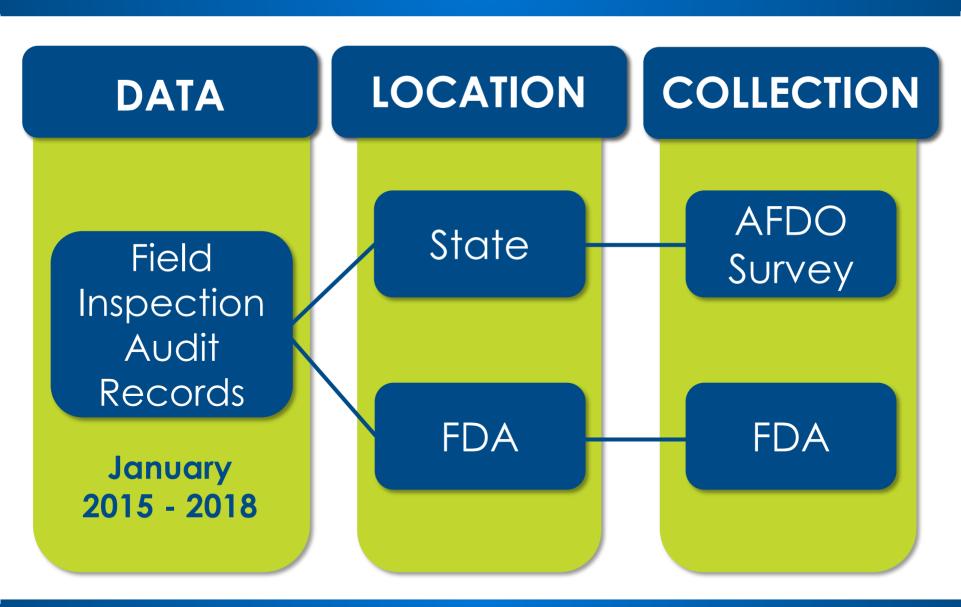

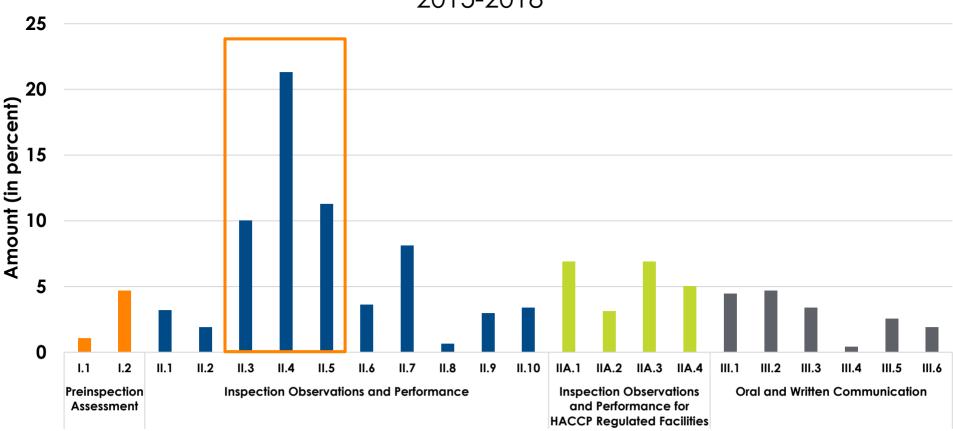

 - 10 FDA Human Food Contracts



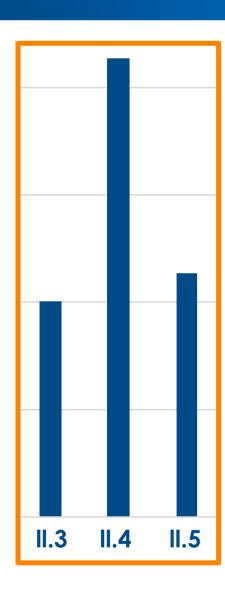

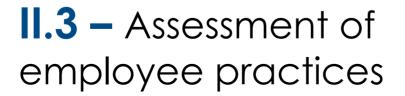

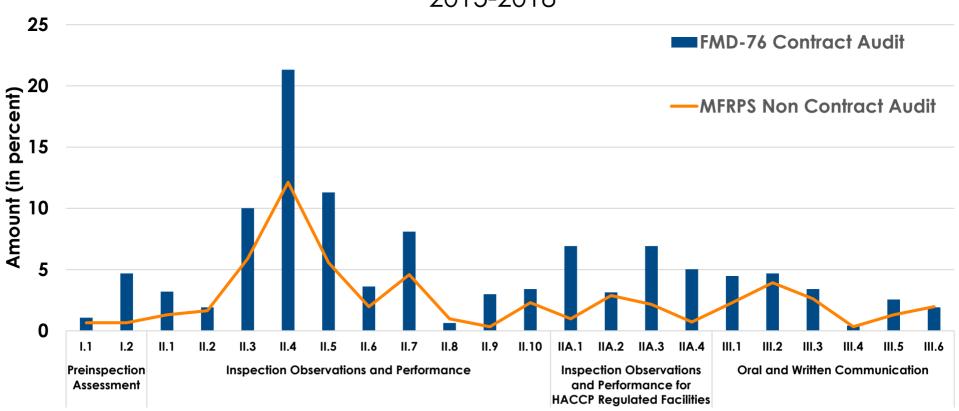

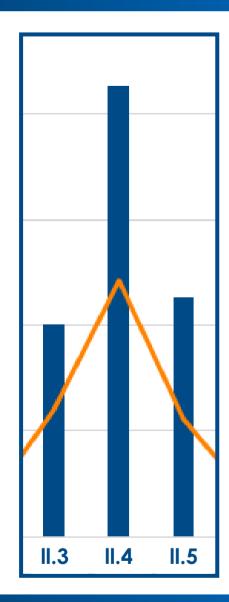

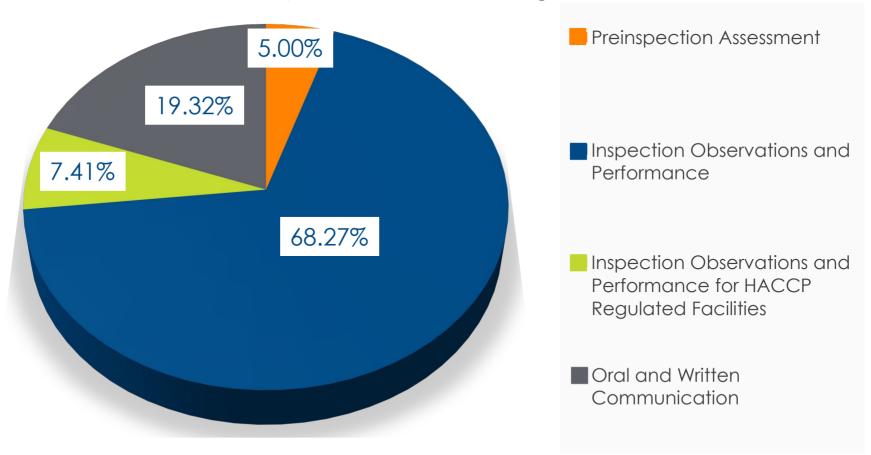
